



Demanding September ...

September is a challenging, yet astrologically speaking, amazingly illuminated month with Mercury Retrograde, two Eclipses, Jupiter stationing in Libra, Saturn and Mars traveling close together, and Saturn squaring Neptune. We will find people on the edge, as many will embrace the messages of this line-up in the Sky. Leo/Aquarius and Taurus/Scorpio might get a 'break', but in studying any natal birth chart, we most likely will notice a point - or two - being touched by the following observations. Mercury Retrograded in the sensitive degree of 29 Virgo on August 30. He will travel in this motion until September 22. A sense of apprehension enters our lives as we approach the month of September, we have to imagine Peace within and continue to have hope among harsh words and uncertain reality throughout the world. However, this is also an exceptionally beneficial period to be patient, re-write proposals, take time out for a healing or massage session, give the canvass another stroke, and contemplate situations thoroughly. The most sensitive Virgo and Pisces energies will feel the effect until October 6 to make sure that all lessons have been taught properly. Mercury is 'home' in Virgo, thus many will be more or less comfortable in their - at times - complicated order of communications. Pisces 'anything' need to repeat sentences, write notes and continue to meditate - most answers are within - after all !!! Attention to details might help matters coming our way, but we still need to clarify our intentions at the end of September. September 1

Solar Eclipse, (5:03 AM, EDT), at 9 degrees of Virgo. The lunar nodes are the orbital nodes of the Moon, that is, the points where the orbit of the Moon crosses the ecliptic. The ascending node, the North Node, is where the moon crosses from south of the ecliptic to north of the ecliptic, i.e. the future, and what we strive to understand. The descending node, the South Node, i.e., the past, and what we need to let go of, is where it crosses from north of the ecliptic to south of the ecliptic. Let's take a look at the New Moon Eclipse first, which is the Sun/Moon in Virgo, thus, a North Node Eclipse. The Sun/Moon is in opposition to Neptune which promise interactions with others, misunderstandings will occur. Sun/Moon conjunct North Node is the necessary steps toward healing and understanding our involvement with emotions versus power struggles, especially with other people. The Pisces/Virgo eclipse season began on March 20, 2015 and linger until February 2017 ... we can also observe it's existence by looking back 18.6 years ago ... or move forward! With Jupiter and Mercury conjunct, there will be confusion with words flying off the wall ... easy does it! Gemini and Sagittarius points will have challenging days, so count your degrees and be aware - praying helps!

September 9,

The trickster God Jupiter, moves into Libra, the peace seeking sign can cause a certain friction together with Jupiter who can't be trusted. Those that have the good luck charmer well placed, and deserve a bonus, or a raise, will get it! Some will fall in Love ... way too fast! Jupiter will approach Pluto, forming a square in November - after the November 8th US election. 'Who', you might ask, 'is the winner'? Hillary Clinton ... just saying!

September 10,

Saturn (government, control, bosses and discipline) square Neptune (illusion, water, and spirituality). Let's make sure to take one day at a time and show gratitude over our safety and comfort! The connection of 'then' and the 'now' is to understand that our achievements are noted. Saturn and Neptune met before in November of 2015, and on June 18, 2016, so, those that continue walking their path will benefit by looking within and outside their reality and life - unconditionally. The power of the last time Saturn square Neptune shows us the intensified facts of the Global shifts of migrant in the millions into countries claiming to welcome them, an offensive USA presidential election with controversial, racist, and not political ethical manners challenging from the Saturn/Neptune square. The reality (Saturn) continue attempt to make sense out of confusion (Neptune), and those impressions are ... chaotic on many and all levels! Oh, not in your life? Great!

September 16,

This Full Moon Eclipse (3:05 PM, EDT), at 24 degrees 20 in Virgo shows Mercury involved (still in Retrograde) with the message of honesty, integrity and commitment to clarity. Many will be exhausted and realize how irritating opinions might sound to others - especially our political views - and we retreat into our own words and we keep quiet ... Neptune, Chiron, and the Moon in Pisces, with the South Node allows us to dwell deeper into our abyss of work, socializing, the Yoga mat, the commitment to our Sadhana (spiritual practices), and that Self within that watches, listens and speaks the truth. The observer advise us in our dream, meditation, contemplation, or driving down the highway! A Wise Sage once said, "Everything is Karma" ... It is our goal to surrender and appreciate our daily prayers and hope for Peace in our Hearts, and the World. During the phase of the Eclipses, weather conditions, people and circumstances around us often intensifies, as well as force us to confront issues hidden deep within our psyche. Eclipses doesn't occur without the involvement of the Moon's Nodes. These Nodes, 'knots' are woven together in our subconscious, manifested by our awareness of who we are 'becoming'. The Sun and the Moon requires to be lined-up within a certain degree to cause an Eclipse, which then allows the Moon (Soul) and the Sun (Spirit) interact accordingly, i.e. we become conscious of our own actions and reactions.

Chiron, the ultimate healing God, is close in degree during both Eclipses which allow those that seek solitude greater healing!

Check your own astrological chart, or book a reading, and notice where the below planets are travelling to the end of 2016. Jupiter in Libra, 4 - 16 degrees, Saturn in Sagittarius, 11 - 17 degrees, Uranus in Aries, 24 degrees, 20 - 24 degrees, Neptune in Pisces, 9 - 10 degrees, Pluto in Capricorn, 15 degrees, and Uranus in Aries, 20 - 24 degrees. The above Eclipses and demanding September make us embrace the Sky and continue to appreciate every day as a beginning of a "new dawn" here on Earth ...
